

Old Testament
Beginning of the 15th

Passover Lambs are being killed (sacrificed) and blood is being drained to be used for marking the lentils and door post of the Israelites' homes. Exodus 12:6

New Testament
Beginning of the 15th

[Luke 23:56](#) They rested on the 1st Day of Unleavened Bread. This is a Sabbath (rest day), but not a Sabbath of Rest (Sabbath Sabbath-town).

6:00 PM
Lentils and door post are marked with the blood of the lambs before sunset. [Exodus 12:7, 13](#)

7:00PM to 11:00PM
Lambs are roasted without basting which makes the roasting take longer. They are not allowed to leave their homes until morning. [Exodus 12:8-9; 20-28](#)

Mid-night
YHWH spares the firstborn of Israel from death. [Exodus 12:12-13 and v29](#)

1:00 AM to 5:00 AM
Roasted lambs are eaten with bitter herbs. Israelites cannot leave their homes before morning. [Exodus 12:8-10](#) This is a night much to be remembered. [Exodus 12:42](#) Moses and Aaron were summoned by night to go to Pharaoh.

Moses and Aaron most likely left at daybreak to have a visit with Pharaoh because Yahuwah had given the command not to leave their homes until morning. Exodus 12:31 Israelites are burning the rest of the lamb if any was left over. Exodus 12:10 They are also spoiling the Egyptians again. Exodus 12:29-36

6:00 AM
7:00 AM to 6:00 PM
As they prepare their carts, wagons, animals, etc. for leaving Egypt, they see the Egyptians burying their dead. Israel leave by adversity (much has happened and they fear that Pharaoh will retaliate). [Exodus 12:39-41, 51: 14:8](#)

New Testament

The Jews ate their Passover Lambs and remember how Yahuwah passed over the firstborn of Israel both man and beast. (Amanuwal's blood cleanses us of our sins... i.e. our sins are passed over.) They also remembered how Israel was brought out of Egypt (sin). Exodus 12:42, 13:14

Continue eating unleavened bread for 7 full days. Today they will meet in the synagoue for a Holy Convocation as commanded. [Exodus 12:11-20; I Corinthians 4:3-6, 6:8](#)
